Cristin Tierney Gallery is pleased to present *PAPER*, an online exhibition devoted to one of the most plastic of media. Looking beyond the act of



traditional drawing, *PAPER* considers how artists use the material in unorthodox ways. It opens on Tuesday, December 15th, and continues through Monday, January 25th. Participating artists include Melanie Baker, Terry Berkowitz, Claudia Bitran, François Bucher, Richard Galpin, MK Guth, Malia Jensen, Alois Kronschlaeger, Joan Linder, Jennifer Marman and Daniel Borins, T. Kelly Mason, Dread Scott, Jorge Tacla, Francisco Ugarte, Jeff Wallace, and John Wood and Paul Harrison. The exhibition will be visible at cristintierney.com.

PAPER explores four different ways in which artists transform their medium:

- Some of the artists in *PAPER* use the material to blur the distinctions between different media. (Richard Galpin, Malia Jensen, Jennifer Marman and Daniel Borins, and T. Kelly Mason)
- A variety of artists also employ paper in the service of video and animation. (Terry Berkowitz, Claudia Bitran, Jorge Tacla, and John Wood and Paul Harrison)
- In other instances paper acts as a record of the artist's process. (François Bucher, MK Guth, Alois Kronschlaeger, Dread Scott, and Tim Youd)
- And rounding out this exhibition is a series of self-reflexive works that demonstrate an appreciation for all things "meta." (Melanie Baker, Joan Linder, and Jeff Wallace)

The artists in *PAPER* use a variety of techniques to experiment and push the boundaries of what paper can be. Disparate in their approaches, each of the artists ultimately transform this simple material into something more than the sum of its parts.
